More and more municipalities are looking for ways to reduce exposure to wrongful lawsuits. For that reason, it is important to get more interviews on the record and into the archives, especially when juveniles are involved. CIMM offers a number of features to help protect yourself as well as your citizens. All original video data recorded on a Sanyo DSR-M810 DVR entered is encrypted for authentication to show that it is original data. Authentication can be performed using the CIMM playback utility. Data burned to a DVD will not have this authentication, but it is preserved in the original video in the CIMM files. All data remains

searchable even after it has been burned to a disc as well. When a DVD is burned for consumer players, using the disclosure feature will generate closed caption information showing key titles as well as time and date of the original recording.
